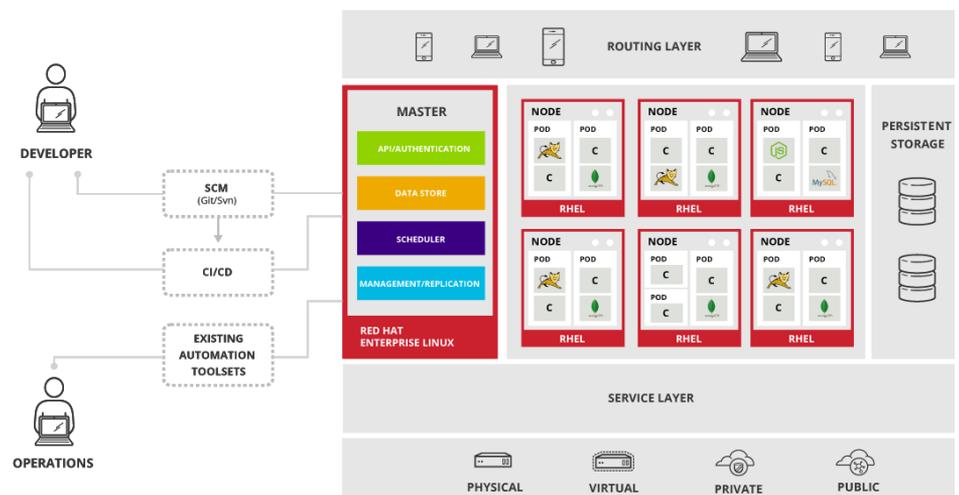

The latest version of Red Hat's OpenShift is much more flexible service-based PaaS, underpinned by Docker and Kubernetes. Docker containers wrap a piece of software in a complete filesystem that contains everything needed to run (such as the code, runtime, libraries and system tools), so that the software always runs the same, regardless of the environment. Kubernetes is an open source container cluster manager which provides a platform for automating deployment, scaling, and operations of application containers across clusters of hosts.
